It is the policy of the Princeton Plasma Physics Laboratory to conduct its operations and research in a manner such that the health and safety of employees, the environment, and the public are protected. Consistent with PPPL P-003, ES&H Policy, is committed, in all its activities, to reduce any safety or health risks associated with ionizing radiation to levels that are as low as reasonably achievable (ALARA). Both individual and collective exposures shall be maintained as far below DOE and PPPL administrative limits as social, economic, practical, and public policy considerations permit.

The Princeton Plasma Physics Laboratory Radiological ALARA Plan is the implementing document which shall be used by line management to ensure that worker and public exposures to ionizing radiation are consistent with this policy.
